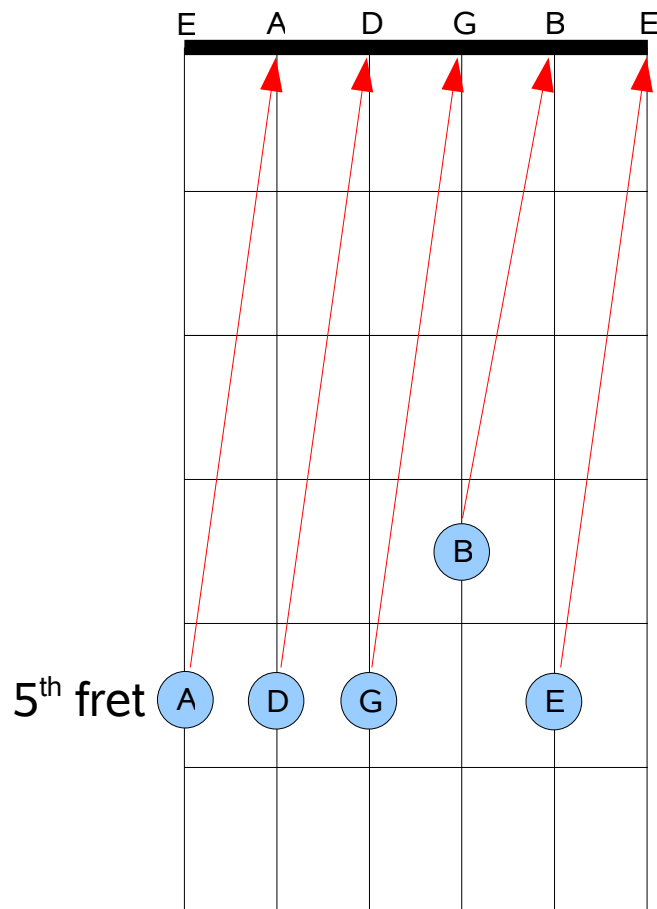


Tune by Fretting the Notes



Low E String

Start by tuning your low E string to another instrument, a song you know is in the key of E, a tuning fork, pitch pipe or just use your ear to get it close.

A String

To tune the A string, play the A note on the 5th fret of the low E string. Turn the tuning peg for the A string up or down to match the pitch you are playing on the low E string.

D String

To tune the D string, play the D note on the 5th fret of the A string. Turn the tuning peg for the D string up or down to match the pitch you are playing on the A string.

G String

To tune the G string, play the G note on the 5th fret of the D string. Turn the tuning peg for the G string up or down to match the pitch you are playing on the D string.

B String

To tune the B string, play the B note on the 4th fret of the G string. Turn the tuning peg for the B string up or down to match the pitch you are playing on the G string.

E String

To tune the high E string, play the E note on the 5th fret of the B string. Turn the tuning peg for the E string up or down to match the pitch you are playing on B string.
